

TEACHING SCENARIO - SCHOOL

A school teacher wants to find a lesson plan that a colleague has produced for activities on a geography field trip.

The teacher is part of a "schools digital network" which includes an **intraLibrary** digital repository. After logging on the teacher searches for the lesson plan by using the name of the colleague. It becomes clear that this colleague is a prolific producer of lesson plans as the list is enormous so the teacher chooses a more advanced search and adds "geography, geology, fossils" to the keywords search. Once the lesson plan is located the teacher prints it and uses it on the field trip.



The lesson plan is very useful so the teacher decides to add a comment and star rating to the entry in **intraLibrary**. This process allows people to add comments to each object they use so that others can use it as a form of quality control. While making a comment the teacher realises there are many other annotations for this particular lesson plan and decides to check the annotations next time on each use of the digital repository.

The teacher also adds her own resource list and some new ideas to the lesson plan and submits it to **intraLibrary** so that other teachers can use it.
