

## TEACHING SCENARIO - SCHOOL

### **A maths teacher in England searches for whiteboard resources for a lesson on percentages**

A teacher is searching for resources to use on an interactive whiteboard in a lesson on percentages. He logs into a national digital repository using his intraLibrary account and browses through the National Curriculum topics. The class is at Key Stage 3, the subject is maths and the topic is Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.

The teacher finds several resources but some need to be bought and some are for printing as handouts. He narrows the search to interactive material and discovers an interactive PowerPoint presentation prepared by a teacher in another town which gets students to calculate the percentage saving in changing their mobile phone from one tariff to another.



The teacher downloads this ready for use and decides to search for other items provided by the same teacher. There are several more that will be useful later in the year so the teacher saves the search as a “news feed”. Without logging into the national repository again the teacher is automatically informed every time a new resource is provided by the teacher whose work he likes.
